


REMEMBERING OUR FOUNDING FATHERS

The Miracle of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Statue of Rosano



In the evening of April 4, 1948, in Rosano, Italy, the first Sunday after Easter, during the chanting of vespers, **people noticed for the first time that drops as if of blood were falling from the eyes of the statue.** In June of that year, another stunning and unexpected miracle occurred - **the flow of blood.** These events occurred repeatedly between 1948 and 1950 and were **corroborated by many eyewitnesses.**

In the monastery archives are preserved many sworn testimonies even of priests, preachers and visitors, together with **medical analyses of the blood**, as well as **finger towels and purificators soaked with blood.**

Christ's face has an **intense expression of manly sweetness which invites all to prayer.** The Heart is at the center of his chest, surrounded by a crown of thorns.


