Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's Gospel has **two related images**: Jesus **teaching His disciples to pray**, and the **story of a pesky neighbor**. Unlike Mathew's version of the Lord's Prayer which has seven petitions, Luke's has only five, omitting "Thy will be done" and "deliver us from evil." It is still valid.

The pesky neighbor is the one who requests bread at midnight and receives what he requested either because of friendship or just because of his persistence.

There are **four kinds of prayer**, forming the acronym **ACTS: A**: Adoration, **C**: Contrition, **T**: Thanksgiving, **S**: Supplication. From the first reading, we see that **prayer can change God's mind!** But God's essence never changes.

On August 4, 2000, His Eminence Ricardo J. Cardinal Vidal, Archbishop of Cebu, established **Mary Queen of Heaven Missionaries** as a Catholic Association of the Faithful

in the Archdiocese of Cebu. On August 22, 2003, and the occasion of the Feast of the Queenship of Mary, Cardinal Vidal canonically elevated **Mary Queen of Heaven Missionaries** to a *Public Association of the Faithful* in the Archdiocese of Cebu, recognizing Sr. Ma. Corazon J. Salazar as foundress and the six original sisters as cofounders, as well as Msgr. Frederick B. Kriekenbeek who had helped them over the formative years.


