The Third Sunday of Advent



Thoughts on today's readings:

The First Reading tells us "to shout for joy" and NOT to be discouraged.

The Psalm rejoices that, in midst of the Savior, we are confident and unafraid.

In the Second Reading St. Paul calls on the Church to rejoice, to *have no anxiety,* but to approach God with prayer and thanksgiving.

In the Gospel, John the Baptist preaches the "good news" - which is that **Christ is coming.** The Christ who will baptize with the Holy Spirit and with fire. **Looking** forward to that coming, we rejoice.

In the midst of what is arguable the busiest month of the year, isn't quiet joy exactly what we need?

just as it was last year.




Advent Prayer


