The Eucharistic Miracle of Saint-Andre de la Reunion

In the Eucharistic Miracle of Saint-Andre de la Reunion, a French Colony in 1902, Abbot Henry Lacombe, pastor of the church, was witness to the miracle that he would **recount to thousands of people during the Eucharistic Congress of Angouleme (1904)**, as well as to the group of priests gathered for a spiritual retreat in the town of Perigueux.

The **face of Jesus appeared in the Host** which was for **many hours witnessed by thousands of people**. Journalists and people from the capital of Saint Denis also arrived. **The face on the Host suddenly became animated and the crown of thorns disappeared**. Later, the vision changed again **and a crucifix appeared which covered the entire Host from top to bottom**.
