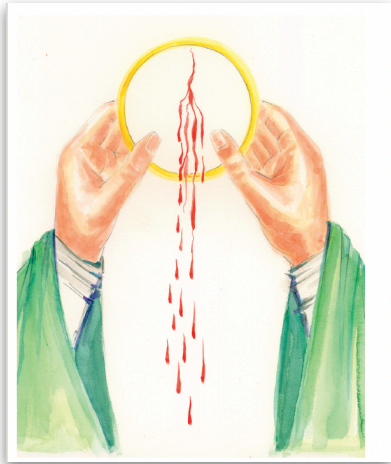
Eucharistic Revival Prayer

The Eucharistic Miracle of Meerssen



In the ***Eucharistic Miracle of Meerssen, Netherlands in 1222 and 1465***, two important Eucharistic miracles took place. The first occurred ***during Holy Mass, when living Blood dripped from the large Host and stained the corporal***. The second occurred in 1465, when ***a farmer was able to rescue the relic of the miracle from a fire that had destroyed the whole church***. The church was later rebuilt, and in 1938 Pope Pius XI raised it to a minor basilica. Numerous pilgrims come every year to Meerssen to venerate the relic of the miracle.
