The Sixth Sunday of Easter

In todays's Gospel, Jesus says that he leaves us peace as his gift, but **this is not a peace that the world can give**. It is peace with God and self and neighbor, not with the world, the flesh, and the devil. Between these two kinds of peace there is war. Life is a spiritual warfare between the two kinds of peace. **Jesus' peace** does not mean a vague sleepy, easy tolerance, a nondiscrimination peace with everything. It **means intolerance of sin and selfishness in yourself. His peace is not the world's peace.**



Jesus also says, "If you loved me, you would rejoice that I am going to the Father." Why is it better for us to have the Holy Spirit, after Pentecost, that to have Jesus physically present? Because it is his Spirit we have, so we have Jesus more fully, more interiorly more intimately than before the Spirit came.
