“The Ascension of Jesus into heaven,” **Pope Francis** said,

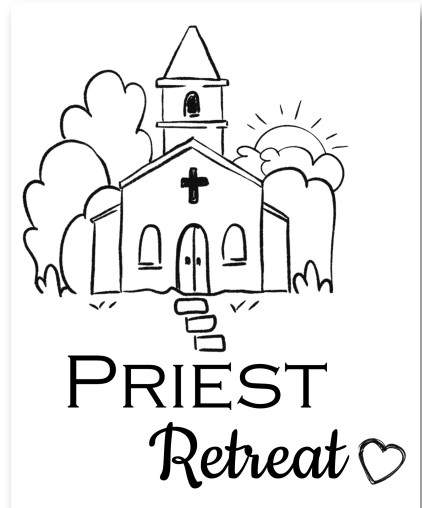
“acquaints us with this deeply consoling reality on our journey: in Christ, true God and true man, our humanity was taken to God. Christ opened the path to us. If we entrust our life to him, if we let ourselves be guided by him, we are certain to be in safe hands, in the hands of our Savior.”

Pope Benedict XVI wrote, it would be a mistake to interpret the Ascension as “the temporary absence of Christ from the world.” Rather, “we go to heaven to the extent that we go to Jesus Christ and enter into him.” **Heaven is a person: “Jesus himself is what we call ‘heaven.’”**

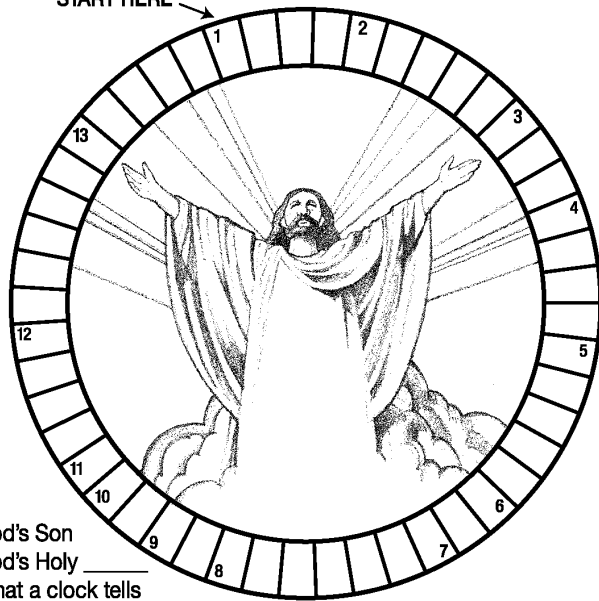


Ascension of the Lord

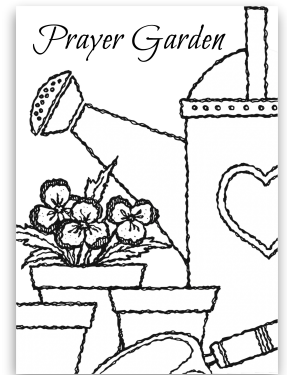
