Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In Sirach, the Lord says: If you choose you can keep the commandments. To whichever you choose: the fire of the Holy Spirit or the water of baptism, stretch forth your hand! God's grace enables us to "observe his law and keep it with all our hearts."

In Psalm 119, "Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord!" is a long psalm telling of the benefits of keeping God's law.

In the second reading, Paul tells us that "real wisdom is God's" —hidden, mysterious, planned and prepared from the very beginning for the glory of those who love the Lord;

In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus says he came not to abolish the law but to fulfill it. (This is the basis for the expression "to cross all the "Ts" and dot the "Is".) He describes such fulfillment as a matter not of legal argumentation but of holiness, reconciliation and the obedience of faith.

Who was Sirach?

The Book of Sirach, or Ecclesiasticus, is one of the latter books of the old Testament. It was written by Jesus ben (son of) Sirach, who was a teacher, scholar, and poet in Jerusalem about one hundred eighty years before Jesus, the Messiah.

It was originally written in Hebrew and translated into Greek some fifty years later by his grandson. During these fifty years there had been a violent persecution of the Jews by the Seleucid kings in order to force them to adopt Greek religion and culture. It was to counteract this influence that his book was written—be faithful to following the law of the Lord.

St. Valentine is the Patron Saint of affianced couples, bee keepers, engaged couples, epilepsy, fainting, greetings, happy marriages, love, lovers, plague, travelers, and young people. He is represented in pictures with birds and roses and his feast day is celebrated on February 14.
