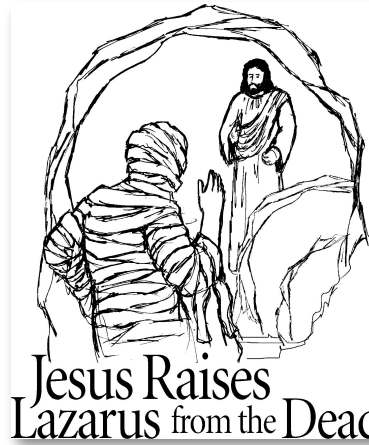

## *What is the Chrism Mass?*

The Chrism Mass is usually celebrated on the *morning of Holy Thursday*. It is the time the *Bishop blesses the sacred oils used in the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Orders, and in the Anointing of the Sick*. It is the time *priests renew their vows*

Because of travel distances, in our diocese, this special Mass is celebrated on Thursday before Holy Thursday.

The oils from the previous year are *burned in the fire on Holy Saturday*.

**Holy Chrism is a mixture of olive oil, an aromatic resin and balsam.**

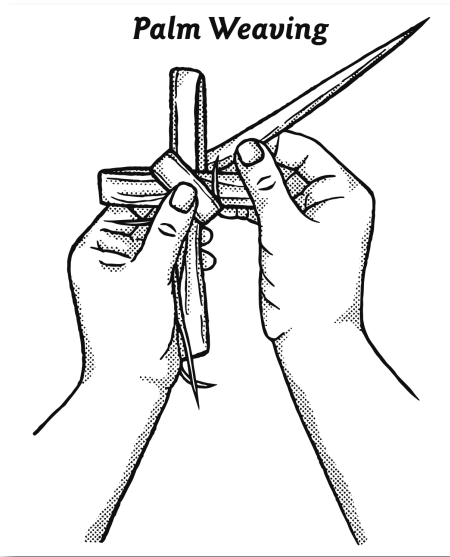
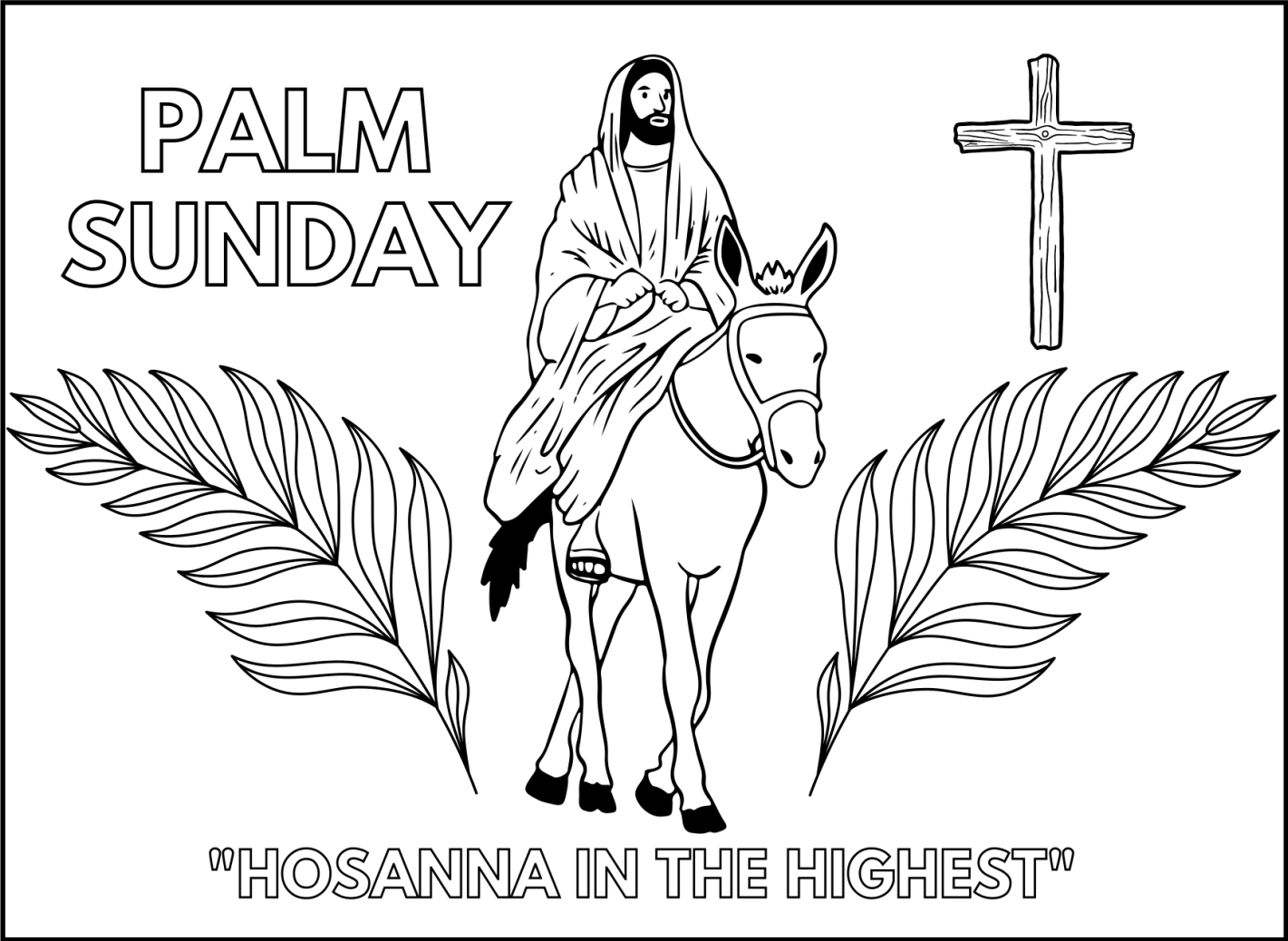

Coloring Page to Hang on Church Bulletin Board



When you arrive for **Mass on Palm Sunday**, you will receive **palm fronds to hold** during the opening procession. You may take those palms home and can tuck them **behind a crucifix on the wall or hang them over a door**. Some people braid and weave palms into elaborate patterns - such as crosses, roses or crowns of thorns. **You can try to weave your palms into a simple cross**. These blessed palms are a **sacramental that can remind us of Holy Week all year long**.
