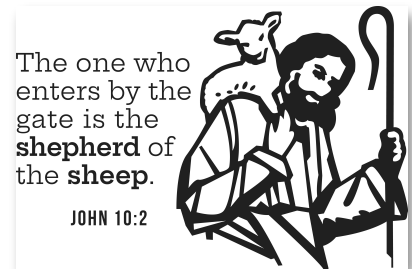

The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep.

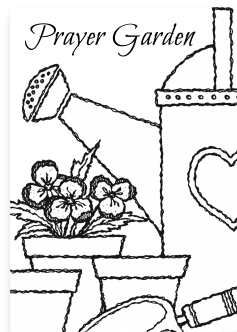
JOHN 10:2

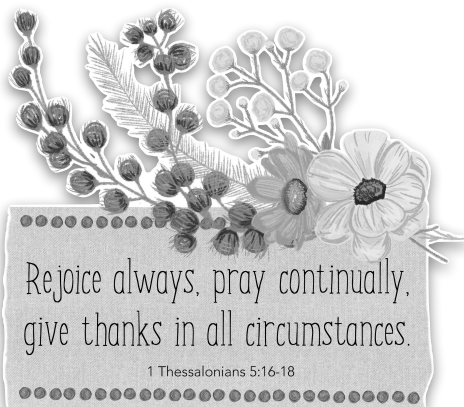
