Today the priest wears **red vestments** and the **altar cloth is red**. Red can remind us of the fire of the **Holy Spirit**. It is the last day of the **Easter Season**.

In the early **prayer books**, the Saints' days and church festivals were printed in red ink. Some prayer books are still printed in this style and many calendars [especially church calendars] have **Sundays and holidays indicated by red letters**. So, a "red-letter day" is one that we look forward to with **pleasure** or look back upon with **joy**.

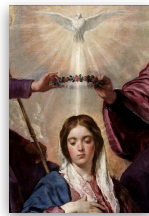
