In today's Gospel, we meet Simeon and Anna. Simeon is a righteous and devout man, who is awaiting God's consolation for those in exile. **The Holy Spirit revealed to him the Christ Child.** Embracing the child, he declares that deliverance is now at hand: "Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace...for my eyes have seen your salvation...."

Anna, a prophetess and widow, lived and worshipped in the temple night and day. She, also, recognizes the child as the Lord and gives thanks to God for seeing the Lord.

Simeon's words to Mary - "...and a sword will pierce through your own soul, also." - is the first of Mary's seven sorrows.
