



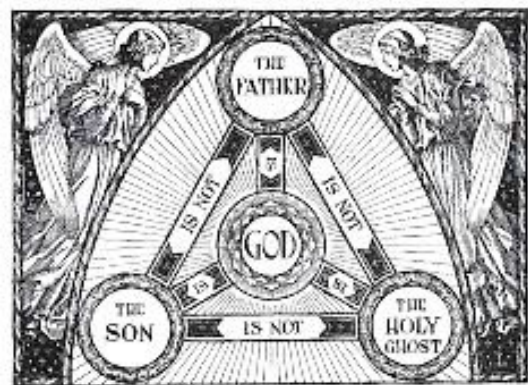

in the Blessed Sacrament.*

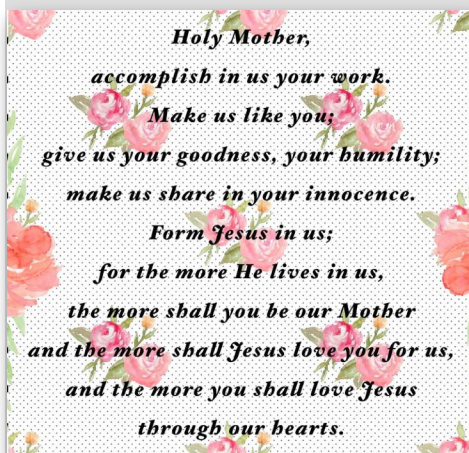
*Our Lady of the Most Blessed Sacrament,

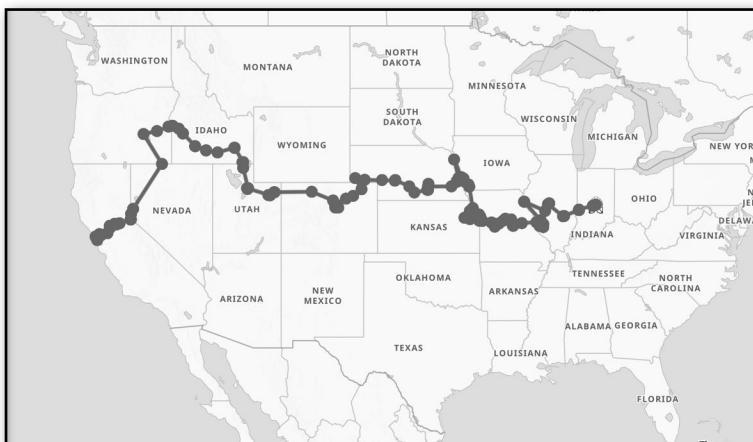

## Eucharistic Miracle of Onil

*In the Eucharistic miracle of Onil, Spain in  
1824 a pyx containing a **consecrated Host** was  
robbed from a parish church.*



Days later, a woman from the nearby town of Tibi recovered the stolen pyx with the **consecrated Host inside in the middle of a green field**. Exactly **119 years later**, on November 28, 1943, Don Guillermo Hijarrubia, delegate of the Archbishop of Valencia, confirmed the authenticity of the miracle, verifying the complete preservation of the Host, reinforcing the promise **"I am with you always."**

## May - The Month of Mary

In 2010, I went on a **Pilgrimage to Egypt and Israel**. In Cairo, we went to Virgin Mary Coptic Orthodox Church in Zeitoun. **Our Lady appeared** over the domes of this church to **millions** for more than a year, starting on Tuesday, April 2, 1968.

The apparitions lasted from only a **few minutes up to several hours** and were sometimes accompanied by **luminous heavenly bodies shaped like doves and moving at high speeds**. The apparitions were seen by millions of Egyptians and foreigners. Among the witnesses were **Orthodox, Catholics, Protestants, Moslems, Jews and non-religious people** from all walks of life. The **sick were cured and blind persons received their sight, but most importantly large numbers of unbelievers were converted...**

On the evening of Sunday, April 28, 1968, an envoy from the Vatican arrived, saw the apparitions and sent a report to His Holiness Pope Paul VI of Rome.
