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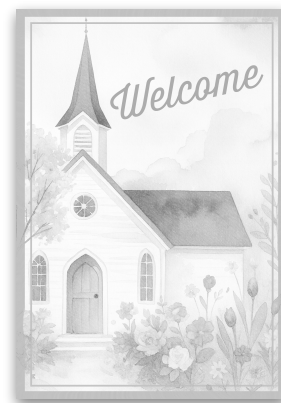
Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The events of today's Gospel, take place north of Israel, near the pagan seaside cities Tyre and Sidon. In the story, it is insignificant that **the disciples are more surprised by Jesus' gift of a miracle to this Gentile woman than she was.** Jesus says to her at the end "Great is your faith!" **He does not say that to his disciples** when they advise him to turn her away. They do not give her a lesson in faith: she gives them a lesson in faith.

This meeting between Jesus and the Gentile woman is **one of the only two examples of Jesus losing an argument.** Jesus never lost an argument to any man, but twice he lost an argument a woman: here and to his mother at the wedding feast of Cana.
